### 7.1.3 ENVIRONMENTAL PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BEYOND THE CAMPUS

#### 1. Activity: River bank Cleanliness Drive, 2022

**Date:** 02/04/2022

**Organized by:** NCC Unit, B.P Chaliha College

**Details:** In keeping with Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision for a cleaner environment, the National Cadet Corps (NCC) of B.P. Chaliha College organized a River Bank Cleanliness Drive on April 2, 2022, as part of the nationwide campaign 'Puneet Sagar Abhiyan.' This initiative aimed to clean seashores, beaches, rivers, and lakes of plastic and other waste materials. Under the Puneet Sagar Abhiyan, B.P Chaliha NCC unit conducted a cleanliness drive at Jaljali River.

The event saw active involvement from the local community, which played a crucial role in the success of the drive. Residents, shop owners, and students from nearby schools and colleges joined the NCC cadets in the effort to clean the riverbanks. This collaborative approach fostered a sense of responsibility and unity among participants, as they worked together to remove plastic waste, bottles, and other pollutants from the riverbank.

**Date:** 05/06/2023

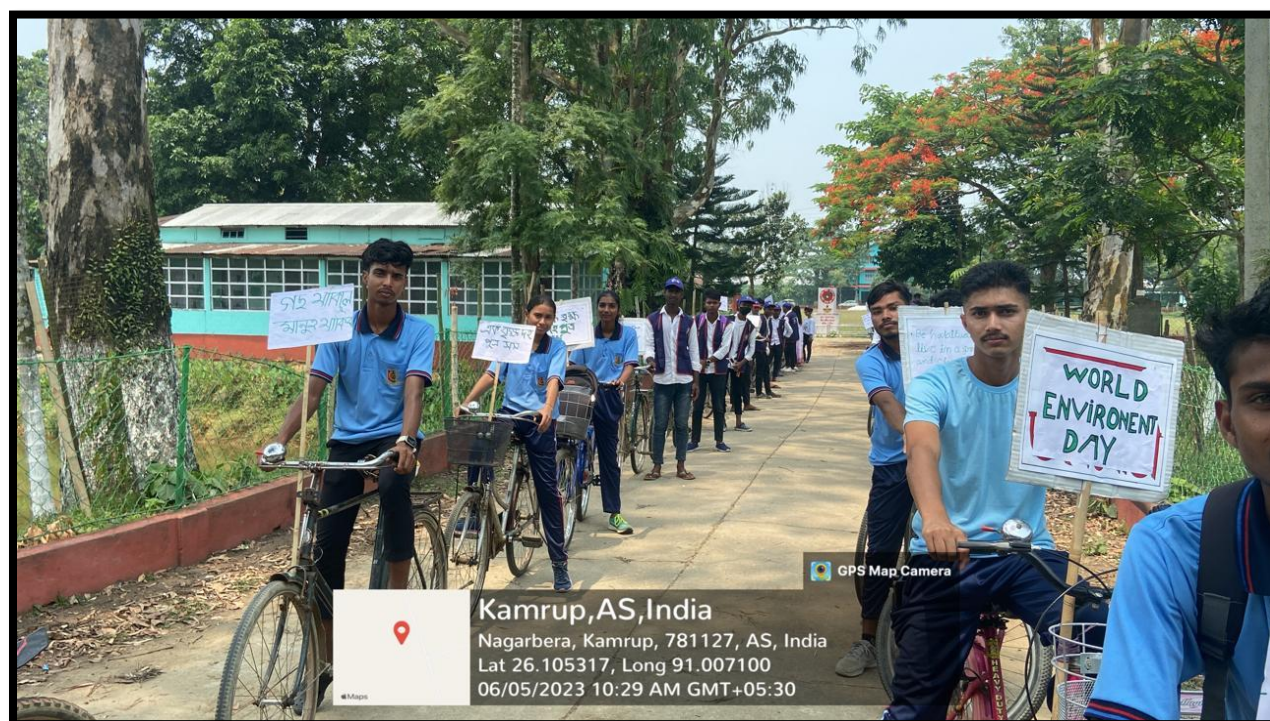
**Organized by:** NCC Unit, B.P Chaliha College

**Details:** The Science forum of B.P. Chaliha College organized a talk on Environment and Climate change in the nearby school of Nagarbera.

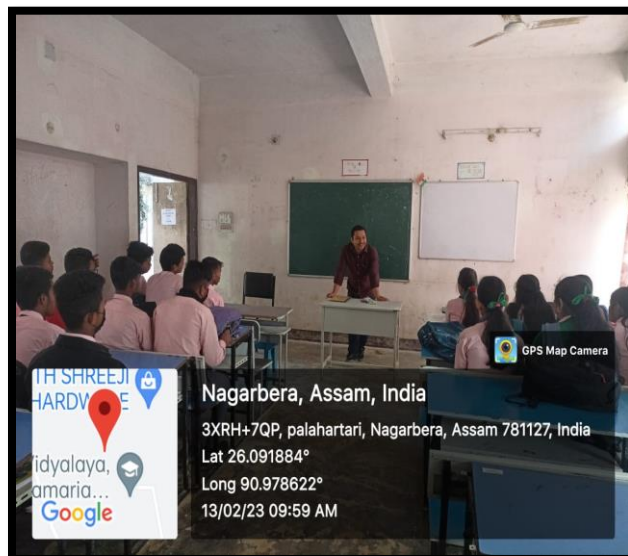


## 11. Activity: Lecture talk on Climate Change, 2023
