B. P. Chaliha College currently has three girls' hostels namely Pratima Barua Pandey girls' hostel, Mamoni Raisom Goswami girls' hostel and S.C. girls' hostel. The hostels are located on the college campus and equipped with all the necessary facilities.

The total boarder capacity of the hostels are mentioned below-

Pratima Barua Pandey girls' hostel: 32

Mamoni Raisom Goswami girls' hostel: 60

S. C. girls' hostel: 28

Admission Rules:

- Hostel admission is approved only after college admission is finalized.
- Hostel accommodation is available for BA/BSc/BCom and HS students.
- BA/BSc/BCom first-semester students and the HS first year students seeking hostel accommodation must complete the relevant section on the college admission form during the admission process.
- The number of hostel seats is limited, and admission is strictly on the basis of academic merit.
- Only outstation students are eligible for hostel admission.

Rules and regulations for the Hostel boarders

- 1) All the Hostel boarders must be present in their respective rooms before 6 P.M.
- 2) Guardian's visit to the ward will be in stipulated time frame as follows:

Every Sunday:	9 A.M. to 5 P.M.
Working days:	5 P.M. to 5.30 P.M.
- 3) The guardian/parent who is the signatory in the admission from a guardian is only allowed to meet the ward in the hostel campus with the prior permission of the Hostel superintendent. No boarders are allowed to go outside the Hostel campus to meet the visitors.
- 4) Passport size photo of the guardian of boarders should be produced to the Hostel superintendent for identity of the guardians.
- 5) Hostel boarders are not allowed to go outside the College Campus without prior permission of the Hostel superintendent.
- 6) Valid Identity Card issued by the College authority must be kept with the boarders in anytime.
- 7) If any boarder needs to leave the Hostel for any reasons, he should inform the Hostel superintendent minimum 3 days in advance.
- 8) The Hostel has its common mess with the provision of cook appointed by the College authority. Hence no boarders in any case are allowed to prepare food in the room.
- 9) Hostel committee is authorized to change or include any reformative steps as and when necessary.
- 10) Violation of the Hostel rules may lead to the expulsion of the boarder from the Hostel as well as from the College.
- 11) No boarder is allowed to indulge in ragging or such activities. Anybody found indulging in such activities will be expelled from the Hostel as well as from College.
