

## Celebration of International Food Safety Day, 2025 on date: 06/06/2025

The International Food Safety Day is observed every year on 7th June to draw attention and inspire action to help prevent, detect, and manage food borne risks, thereby contributing to food security, human health, economic prosperity, and sustainable development. The theme for the year 2025, “*Science in Action*”, focuses on the application of scientific methods and awareness to ensure food safety and combat adulteration. The Department of Botany in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college celebrated International Food Safety Day, 2025 a day in advance on 6th June 2025 at Nagarbera Girls’ High School. The programme witnessed the enthusiastic participation of school students and teachers, alongside faculty members of the college.

The programme commenced with a brief introductory note by the Head of the Department of Botany Dr. S. N. Das, who also presided over the meeting. He elaborated on the significance of the International Food Safety Day and the importance of educating students on food adulteration and scientific food handling practices.
