1. Activity: World Environment Day

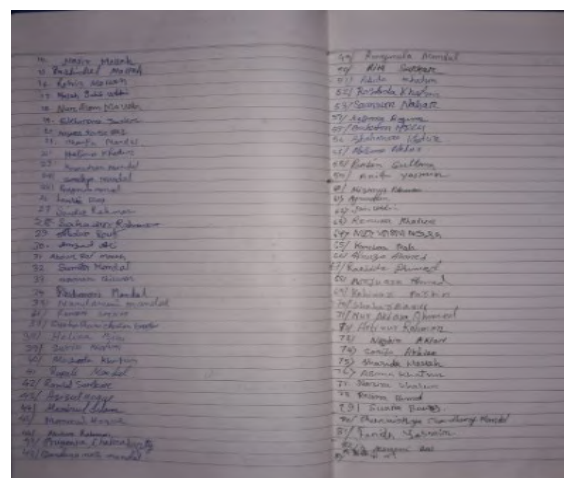
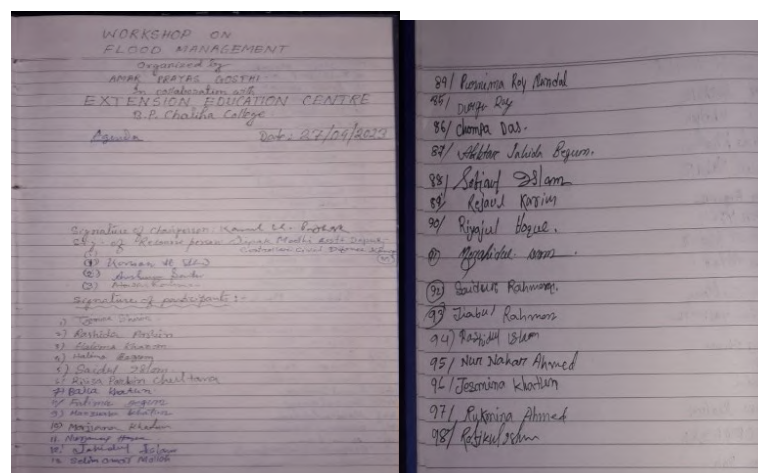
3. Activity: Workshop on Flood Management

Date: 27/04/2023

Objective: The initiative aimed to educate local communities on preparedness measures and sustainable solutions to mitigate the impact of floods. Local residents hailed the initiative as a timely intervention, considering the region's susceptibility to annual floods. Many expressed their appreciation for the practical insights gained during the programme, which they believed would empower them to respond effectively to future flood events.

Details: In a proactive move to address the recurring issue of floods in the region, the Amar Prayax Gosthi, in collaboration with the Extension Education Centre of B.P. Chaliha College, organized a comprehensive flood management and awareness programme. Mr. Dipak Medhi, Assistant Deputy Controller, Civil Defence, Kamrup (M) the resource person, emphasized the urgency of proactive measures in tackling the perennial issue of floods in the region. He stressed the importance of community involvement and awareness in minimizing the loss of life and property during flood incidents. The programme featured a series of informative

sessions and workshops conducted by experts in the field of disaster management and environmental conservation. Topics covered included early warning systems, evacuation procedures, first aid, and the importance of maintaining ecological balance to mitigate flood risks. Additionally, practical demonstrations on the construction of temporary shelters, sandbagging techniques, and basic survival skills were provided to equip participants with essential knowledge in dealing with flood emergencies.

Details: The Science forum of B.P. Chaliha College organized a talk on Environment and Climate change in the nearby Nagarbera HS School, Nagarbera.



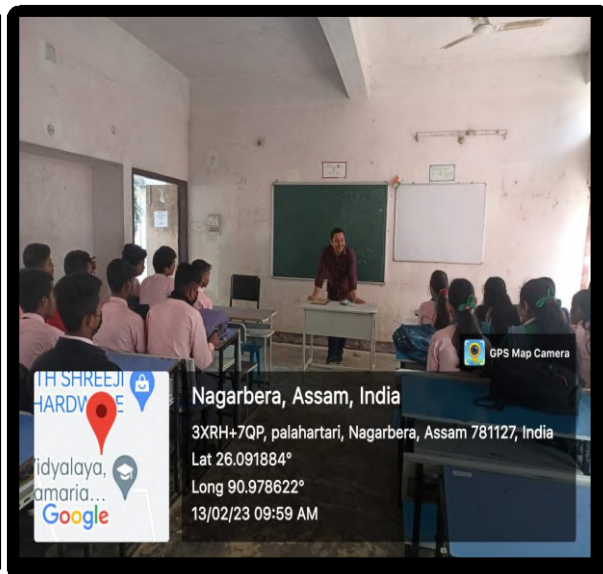
5. Activity: Lecture talk on Climate Change, 2023

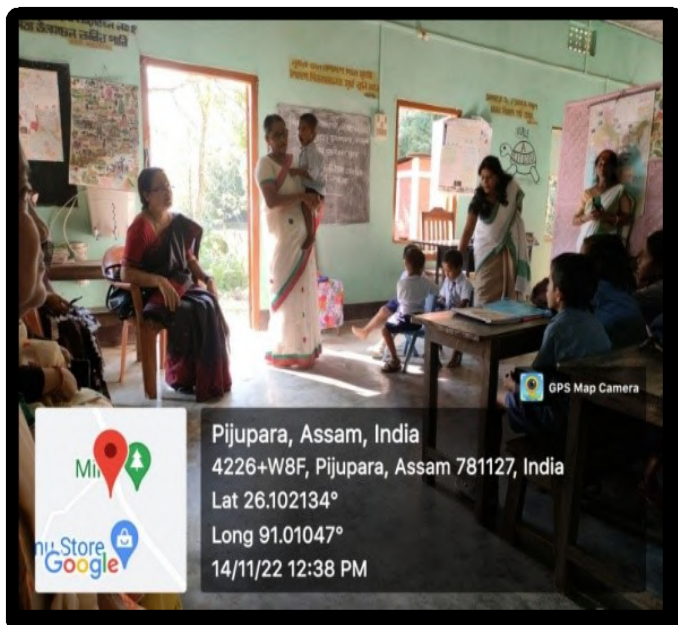


7. Name of event: Extension activity: Children's Day Programme 2022
